What Does it Mean "Paper Recycling."

Paper can be recycled between 5 and 7 times. You will also save oxygen, energy of cutting and growing trees. Not only that but it will also save CO2 which is Carbon Dioxide.



How Paper is Made

Paper is made by trees getting cut down. Then going through a long process. So if we recycle 1 ton of paper we have the equivalent of saving 17 trees.



What About Saving Water

Why We Should Save Paper?
